



SUNSHINE HILLS SPORTS DAY - FRIDAY, JUNE 9th, 2017

Theme “Canada”



- We are looking forward to Sports Day and are hopeful that the weather will cooperate.
- Although we do have an alternate day (Monday, June 12th), Sports Day will only be rescheduled in the event of **very poor** weather (eg. heavy rain). In case of rescheduling, this information will be posted to our blog <https://deltalearns.ca/ecolesunshinehills/>
- As this is an outside day, students should come prepared for the weather (sunscreen, a hat, a jacket, dress in layers, etc...).
- School starts at the regular time of 9:00 am. We will dismiss early, at 2:30 pm.
- Students will be divided into 4 teams (Green, Red, Blue or Yellow) and are encouraged to dress in their team colours. **Students should already know their colour**, as these are the **same as their PE/gym colour groups**. If not, please contact your child's teacher.

Wheels Parade – Primary Students (K-3)



- **Primary Students (Kindergarten to Grade 3)** are invited to decorate bicycles, tricycles, wagons and/or scooters for the Wheels Parade.
- **Helmets are mandatory** for the participation in this special event.
- Students may choose to decorate their wheels in keeping with this year's Sports Day theme - “Canada”, or in their team colours, but they are not limited to this So, use your imagination!
- The Wheels Parade will take place around the perimeter of the school building and on the gravel field, with the spectators standing on the outside of the gravel field or along the parade route. The route will be marked with cones and marshaled by students. As the gravel field is part of the parade route, please plan accordingly when decorating your wheels. Also, for this reason (gravel surface), rollerblades are not allowed.
- Decorated wheels should be brought to the gym between 8:30 and 8:55am, the morning of Sports Day. After dropping off their wheels, students will then report to their classes for attendance.
- The parade start will starts around 9:20 am. After the parade, the “wheels” are returned to the gym
- Parents are encouraged to take the “wheels” home right after the parade (or pick them up at lunch), rather than storing them in the gym till the end of the day. The gym will be off limits during the day.

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Theme "Canada" - SCHEDULE OF EVENTS:

8:30	Grade 7 Students begin setting up stations
8:30 – 8:55	Participants in the Primary (K-3) Wheels Parade drop "wheels" off in gym 12:23-12:55
8:55	Students line up, as usual
9:00	Attendance, as usual
9:10 - 9:15 (approx.)	Wheels parade participants are called to gym & classes/spectators gather in designated spots along course to watch the parade
9:20 – 9:40 (approx.)	Wheels Parade!
9:45	Classes report to their first station Parade participants return wheels to gym & are then escorted to first station by grade 6 helpers.
9:50 – 10:30	Classes rotate through stations. * please note - Students in Kindergarten to Grade 2 (including Mrs Klassen's 2/3 class) will rotate through stations on the lower field. Students in Grade 3 to 6 will rotate through stations on the upper field.
10:30 – 10:50	Recess Break (inside) Students return to the classroom for a quick snack, washroom, warm-up or cool-down break. Ensure your child has a snack that is quick and easy to eat.
10:50 – 11:40	Stations Resume (students return to same station as before recess) Please note, due to time constraints, it's possible that students may not rotate through all stations.
11:40 – 12:05	Clean-Up of field / All equipment put away
12:05	Students return to classrooms
12:08 – 12:23	Lunch (Special Foods/ Hot Lunch for those who ordered it). Students eat in classrooms, as usual. Parents who wish to eat lunch with their children, either off of school grounds or on the playground must notify the child's teacher for safety reasons. Unfortunately, there is not enough space for parents to eat in the classrooms with the children. Hot Lunch is delivered rain or shine, so in case of a rain-out, there will be no hot lunch on the alternate day.
12:23	Students will be dismissed outside for the remainder of the lunch time.
1:00	Students return to classes for afternoon attendance (as usual)
1:05 (approx.)	Classes report to the "hill" on the upper field for afternoon activities
1:10 (approx.)	Pre-School Race & Parent Potato Sack Relay! (We hope that you will consider participating!)
1:25 (approx.)	Grade Group / Colour Team Tug-of-War
2:20	Activities wrap up & students return to classrooms
2:30	Dismissal
